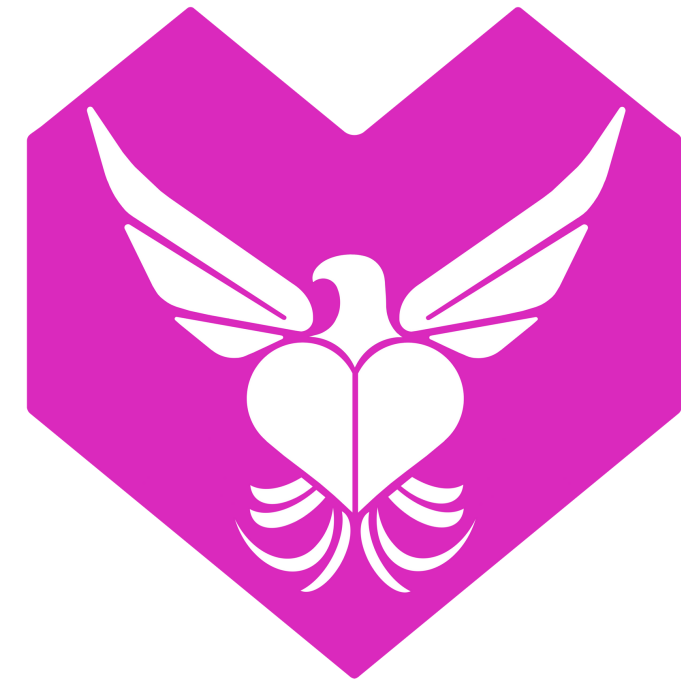

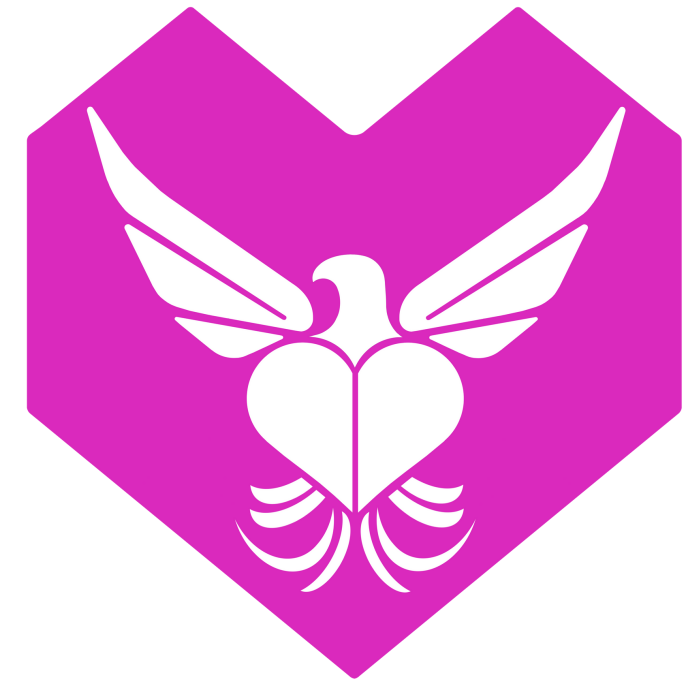

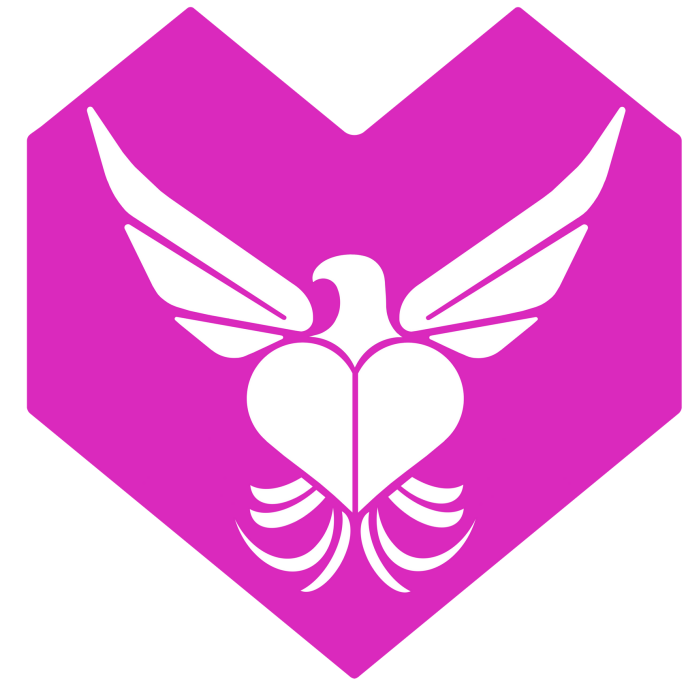
# Community “Jardín”, Oaxaca

The El Jardín neighborhood, located in Oaxaca de Juárez, is strategically positioned between the Donají, San Luis Beltrán, and 7 Regiones districts. This location gives it a particular dynamic, serving as a connecting point between these important areas. The neighborhood is known for being primarily a residential area, with a mix of homes of diverse economic backgrounds, reflecting the socioeconomic diversity of its inhabitants. Its growth has been influenced by the urban expansion of Oaxaca.

According to data from Market Data México, approximately 4,490 people live in Colonia El Jardín, Oaxaca de Juárez, of whom 2,408 are women.



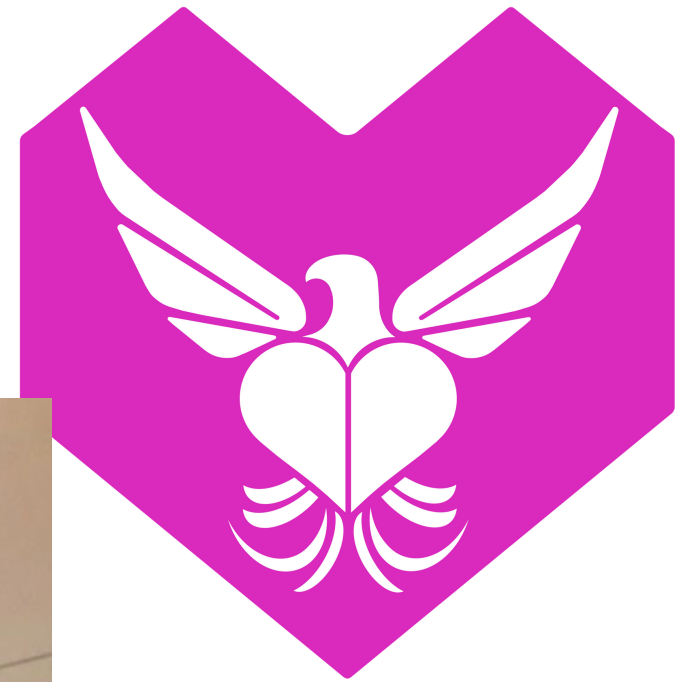

On Sunday, June 22nd, the "Wings of Love" race was held to collect food for 50 women in vulnerable situations in the "El Jardín" neighborhood.

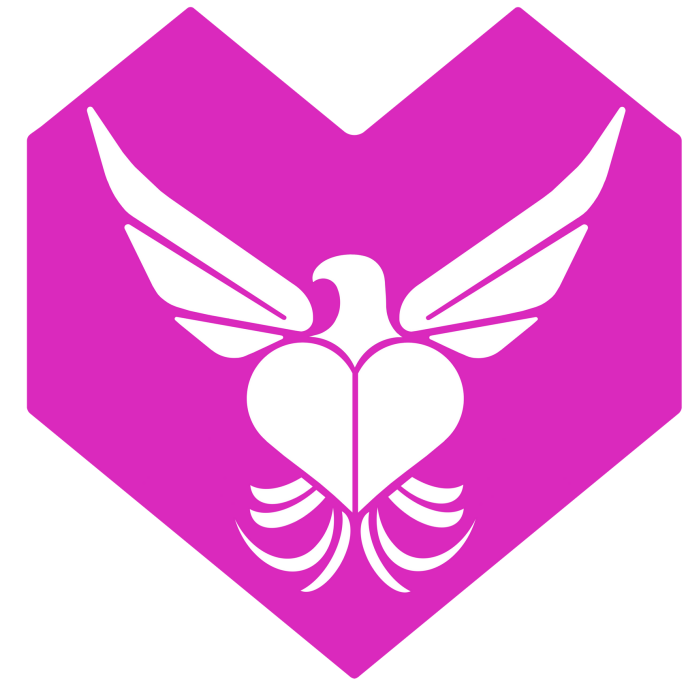

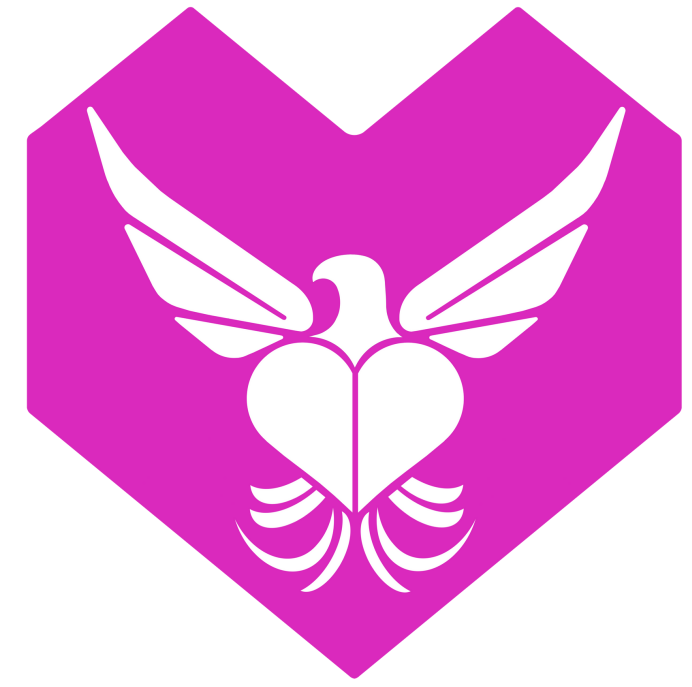
